I am so excited about the upcoming school year and am really looking forward to sharing time with my students. We are going to learn many concepts this year including multiplication and division. We will start a new bible curriculum entitled *Building on the Rock*.

Discipline

Students are expected to be respectful and considerate to students and teachers and to take responsibility for their own actions. This will insure that all students have an appropriate environment for learning.

Students making good choices (ex. following directions, raising hand to speak, being quiet during study time, etc) will be rewarded. Those making bad choices (ex. disrupting class, interrupting when someone is talking, etc.) will have to make restitution for their actions. (lost privileges, etc.)

Rewards include verbal appreciation, awards, candy and small treasures.

Homework

It is to each student's advantage to read in the evening as well as in school. I encourage them to read library books each evening if they can.

There will be some homework. As we progress into the year more math practice will be assigned. It is important that students learn multiplication tables. Students will not have any assigned homework on Wednesday. Any work not completed during school will need to be completed at home and returned the next day in the red homework folder.

Tests

Spelling tests will be scheduled every Friday. Oral quizzes over the weekly Bible verse will be scheduled on Friday as well. Advance notice will be given when other tests are scheduled.

Parties

School parties will be Christmas, God's Love, and Easter. Birthday parties can be scheduled with the teacher as close to the birthday as possible and will be held after 2:25 p.m. Summer birthdays will be celebrated close to the ½ year date.
