


Miss Erin Funk

Policies & Procedures

- Discipline/Classroom Management: Students will be employees of "Eagle Enterprises." Please see the attached pages for more information.
- Tardies: Mrs. Miller and I will are giving the students five minutes between each class to get their books, go to the bathroom, get a drink, etc. We will give a tardy to the students that are late to class. The first tardy is a warning; the second will result in the loss of recess or another privilege; after the third tardy, the student will have to spend recess or another special in the office.
- Homework: I will not regularly assign homework. Most of the homework the students will have will be whatever they haven't finished in class. Occasionally I will assign something extra to be finished at home.
- Assignment Books: Everything that I assign in class is to be written in this book as I assign it. If the student completes it in class, I will initial it, otherwise it is homework. I also require that these get signed by a parent each night. Please sign the book in the box with the date for the day.
- Book-It: This starts in October and goes through March. Each student will be *required* to read 450 pages per month. Book-it will be for a grade this year. The grades will be determined based on how many pages are read up to 450. Each student that reads the entire amount each month will receive the monthly reward.

- Tests & Quizzes: All tests & quizzes will be announced in class ahead of time and will also be included in my note for the week.

Wages, Payments, Raises, & Bills

Wages-You will receive a wage per day just for coming to work on time and having your assignment book signed by your direct supervisor (mom/dad). However, absences or the lack of a signature will result in a lack of payment for the day.

Payment-Payday will be every Monday.

<u>Raises</u>-You have a chance of receiving a raise for going above and beyond the call of duty. You must receive 5 stamps/stickers on your pay raise chart in order to receive a raise. You may get these stickers by getting a 100 on a test.

Bills - Bills will be sent home the first Tuesday of the month and must be signed by your direct supervisor (mom/dad). If you do not have the money to pay your bill you will have to do "community" service" to pay it off. You will be billed for being unprepared for work (class). You will also be billed for each of the following: no name on paper, having to go to your locker, getting your name on the board, not having the supplies you need, not having homework done, turning in incomplete homework, complaining when asked to do something, or anything else that one of the Board of Directors deems permissible.
