These will be given at my discretion. These stickers can be used by students to put on a test or homework assignment where they would like to leave the question blank, and no points will be deducted from the grade for leaving the question blank. These stickers can only be used in Mrs. Wherritt's classes.

Book-it program: This program starts in October and runs through March. Sixth graders are required to read 450 pages a month to qualify. Parents will sign off on students read pages, and students will receive a free personal pan pizza each month. This is an optional program.
