Discipline Plan

Each student will begin the week with three cards. A student will lose a card if he/she breaks a rule or if one of the teachers feels it necessary, because of disruptive reasons. If the child has all the cards by the end of the week, the child will be able to choose a prize out of the "treasure box". If the child only loses one card by the end of the week a prize will be selected by the teacher. I want to work with your child as much as possible and I will give grace daily. Some of the rules of our class are Kindness Always, Soft Voices, Raise your Hand, Listening Ears and Obedient Hearts.

Attendance/Homework

Homework will only be assigned after I have encouraged and worked with your child to complete the assignment in the time frame permitted. In these situations, I ask that you work with your child in the evening to complete this work and return it in your child's backpack the following day.

The scissor box will be the only homework for the first nine weeks. I will have one box that will rotate through all the students. The scissor box will have a pair of scissor and some scissor exercise papers for them to practice on. Please have them finish cutting up the papers the night they bring it home. Return the cut up papers, box and scissors to school the next day. We have one classroom rule with scissors: Only cut paper. Please reinforce this rule at home.

According to school policy, "students who are absent in excess of 10 days in one semester, or 20 days in 2 semesters may be required to repeat that grade." It is important for your child to be here as much as possible so they do not fall behind. However, if know that your child will miss one or more days of school, you are always welcome to let me know so I can send the work home with you.
