If you would like to send in a treat to celebrate your child's birthday, it's okay with me. All treats will be consumed in the afternoon during center time. There are 12 students in our class. Please mail party invitations unless all students in the class will be invited.

Water:

Students are encouraged to bring in a water bottle into the classroom and for use outside at PE. Please, no liquid other than water is allowed. Send water in a closeable water bottle that is labeled with your child's name. We also have a water fountain near the restrooms for refills.

Star Student:

For the first twelve weeks of school I will pick a child as the star student. He/she will receive an "About Me" poster in their Tuesday folder. Please fill out the poster and return it the next day. The poster will be displayed in the classroom for one week so that your children may learn more about their classmates.



Book Orders:

On occasion, scholastic book orders will be sent home. Ordering is purely optional, though all points received from class orders does allow for more books to be ordered for our classrooms. Keep in mind – books make great gifts for kids (and teachers)!

Curriculum Content

In Pre-k we utilize the Abeka curriculum. This a strong Christian based academically proven program. I think you will be amazed at how fast your child will learn. The Bible curriculum is from the Association of Christian Schools International, which is also our accrediting institution. We will have a weekly memory verse. Your child will receive the verse on Monday and I encourage you to help them daily in memorizing the words. Students will say their verses to the teacher on Fridays.

OTHER ACADEMICS

Morning Work:

Most days children have from the time they arrive at school (no earlier than 8:15 am) until about 8:30 am to complete the following items.

- -Work on Bell Work
- -Turn in any Missing Assignments

Please have your child to time before the tardy bell rings so that he or she may begin on time and in a calm fashion with the rest of the class. I appreciate your concern for your child's education!



HOMEWORK

Homework will generally not be assigned. If your child has struggled during a particular day, he or she may have class work that needs to be completed at home and returned the following day.

- **-Tuesday Folders:** Every Tuesday your child will bring home a blue folder. It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that you review the information in the folder and return the necessary papers. You may also send notes to me this way.
- -Report Cards: Will be sent home quarterly, each 9-weeks
- **-Conferences:** Parent/Teacher conferences will be held in October. I am happy to meet with parents at any time regarding concerns about your child.

We have a classroom Treasure Box!!!
