## Attendance/Homework

Homework will only be assigned after the teacher has repeatedly encouraged and worked with your child to complete an assignment in the time from permitted. In these situations, we ask that you work with your child in the evening to complete this work and return it in your child's backpack the following day.

According to school policy, "students who are absent in excess of 10 days in one semester, 20 days in 2 semesters may be required to repeat that grade." It is important for your student to be here as much as possible so they do not fall behind. However, if you know that your child will miss one or more days of school, please let us know and we can send the work home with you.
