2012-2013 FINANCIAL PLAN

Western Oklahoma Christian School is a non-profit organization, and stand as stewards of God. In dependence upon Him, we spend what He provides to educate those who are entrusted to us. The normal way of financing the school is through tuition, which pays the teacher's salaries. The remainder comes through fundraisers and gifts and offerings of interested parents, grandparents, friends, and churches. Our goal is to eventually provide financial aid to worthy but financially unable students.

Students' expenses will include:

A. Tuition per student:

Tuition fees may be paid in ten monthly payments beginning August through May.

Tuition Incentive Plans

- Tuition fees may be paid in full by August 15th with a 5% discount on tuition. (This would make a 1st child's tuition of \$2,450.00 only \$2,327.50; a \$122.50 savings for the family.)
- One-half of the tuition fees may be paid by August 15th and the remaining one-half paid by January 15th with a 3% discount on tuition. (This would make a 1st child's tuition of \$2,450.00 only \$2,376.50; a \$73.50 savings for the family.) Payments due each semester would be \$1,188.25.
 - Payment must be received in the office or postmarked by August 15th or January 15th in order to receive this discount.

Half-day Pre-K & Kindergarten classes are Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM.

All-day Pre-K through 6th grades are Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 3:15 PM.

NOTE: For more than one child, the older child must pay the higher amount with the second, third and fourth child paying decreasing amounts. Full-time pastors will be given a 20% reduction on tuition for their children.

- 1. The first tuition payment is due at Parent Orientation, the first week of August. Tuition payments are due as indicated in the Parent Agreement Form with W.O.C.S. If the child is withdrawn before the end of the first month, the first month tuition payment is non-refundable.
- 2. Tuition must be kept current. A \$20.00 late fee will be added to accounts not paid by the 15th of the month.

B. Book Fees:

<u>Parents are responsible to purchase all books for your student at www.backtobooks.com.</u> All books that are purchased by the parents become property of the student. All books need to be ordered and paid for by July 1, 2012 at www.backtobooks.com. Each student will be given a student number with their acceptance letter after the enrollment interview. Readers can be resold to Back to Books for credit on your account at the end of the school year.

C. Other Expenses:

- 1. Field Trips
- 2. Classroom supplies (pencils, crayons, etc...). Supply packets for the appropriate grade will be available to purchase at the parents' meeting the first week of August. Additional pencils and paper may need to be purchased later in the year.

Do not buy school supplies as teachers' request specific things.
